Aurora and Prevea are looking at how it may be implemented in their organizations. Dr. Brown from UW Madison has been in communication with Shelby and Shelby has been in communication with Aurora leadership regarding possible implementation and costs associated with this. Fond du Lac schools conducts SBIRT by screening all 9 th graders utilizing the Pediatric Symptom Checklist-Youth Report http://www.massgeneral.org/psychiatry/services/psc_forms.aspx and adds 2 questions to it regarding alcohol and drug use and 2 questions regarding suicide ideation.
